
## Create your own 'Flag Bunting'

## What You'll Need

- \* Paper scissors
- \* Glue
- \* Sticky tape
- \* Wrapping paper or coloured paper
- \* Ribbon, twine or string

## What To Do

- 1. Work out the number of pieces you want in your bunting design. Handy hint odd numbers work well.
- 2. Print off your bunting shape and cut them out, leaving 1 cm of paper around the outside edge. Cover the front of each flag with glue. Press the glued side onto the back of the coloured paper.
- 3. Wait until your template has dried before cutting it out. Then, lay your bunting shapes in a row, leaving 2 cm between each shape. Unwind your ribbon or twine the same length as the bunting and allow an extra 25 cm at each end.
- 4. Lay the ribbon or twine down under the line that says 'fold' on your template and stick it in place. Fold the template on the line that says 'fold'. Place more sticky tape down to keep it in place.
  - 5. Hang up your bunting!
